

## Global Pharma Healthcare – Recall of Artificial Eye Ointment

- On February 23, 2023, [Global Pharma Healthcare announced](#) a consumer-level recall of one batch of [Artificial Eye Ointment](#) due to possible microbial contamination and some product packaging is leaking or may otherwise be compromised.
  - Other artificial eye ointment products made by other manufacturers that are not being recalled are available for use.
- To date, Global Pharma Healthcare has not received any reports of adverse events related to this product. The recalled product was distributed by Delsam Pharma.

- Artificial eye ointment is used as a lubricant to prevent further irritation or to relieve dryness of the eyes.
- Use of contaminated eye ointment may cause adverse events, such as eye infection that could lead to blindness.
- Patients who are currently using the recalled artificial eye ointment should stop use and contact their pharmacy or place of purchase for a replacement. Patients should contact their physician or healthcare provider if they have experienced any problems that may be related to using these over-the-counter drug products.
- Anyone with an existing inventory of the recalled product should stop use, distribution, and quarantine the product immediately and arrange for return.
