

Nationwide Pharmaceutical – Recall of ferrous sulfate tablets

- [Nationwide Pharmaceutical announced](#) a consumer-level recall of four lots of [ferrous sulfate](#) 324 mg tablets because of a lack of child safety caps on product containers.
 - Other ferrous sulfate tablets that are not being recalled are available for patients to use.
- The recalled products were distributed nationwide January 2023.

- Ferrous sulfate tablets are dietary supplements. Each tablet contains 324 mg of ferrous sulfate, equivalent to 65 mg of elemental iron, providing 362% of the U.S. recommended daily intake (RDI) of iron for adults and children 4 and older.
- Per Nationwide Pharmaceutical, the overconsumption of ferrous sulfate can result in serious injury or death, especially in children.
- Patients should contact their physician or healthcare provider if they have experienced any problems that may be related to using the recalled ferrous sulfate tablets.
- Anyone with an existing inventory of the recalled product should stop use, distribution, and quarantine the product immediately and arrange for return.
