

## Lohxa - Recall of senna syrup

- On January 11, 2022, <u>Lohxa announced</u> a consumer level recall of one lot of <u>senna syrup</u> 8.8 mg/5 mL unit dose cups due to microbial contamination.
- The recalled lot was to AvKare (wholesaler) who may have further distributed this to clinics, hospitals, and healthcare providers.

- Senna syrup is used to relieve occasional constipation.
- Use of contaminated product by the elderly, patients with a weakened immune system, or patients at
  a higher risk of developing life-threatening inflammation of the heart, could result in infections that
  could be life-threatening.
- To date, Lohxa LLC has not received any reports of adverse events related to this recall.
- Patients who have the recalled senna syrup should contact their physician or health care provider if they have experienced any problems that may be related to using the recalled senna syrup.
- Anyone with an existing inventory of the recalled product should stop distribution and quarantine the product immediately.
