

Nalbuphine Injection - Drug Shortage

- The <u>drug shortage</u> of Hospira's <u>nalbuphine</u> injection is ongoing. Nalbuphine has been unavailable for at least 90 days due to a shortage of an active ingredient.
- Nalbuphine is indicated for the management of pain severe enough to require an opioid analgesic
 and for which alternative treatments are inadequate. It can also be used as a supplement to
 balanced anesthesia, for preoperative and postoperative analgesia, and for obstetrical analgesia
 during labor and delivery.
