

Grifols – Withdrawal of Gamunex-C[®] (immune globulin [human])

- On December 30, 2019, <u>Grifols announced</u> a voluntary, consumer-level withdrawal of one lot of <u>Gamunex-C (immune globulin [human])</u> injection due to a higher rate of allergic/hypersensitivity type reactions, a small number of which were considered medically significant.
- The withdrawn Gamunex-C was distributed in the U.S. and had a market release date of July 19, 2019.

- Gamunex-C is indicated for the treatment of primary humoral immunodeficiency in patients 2 years of age and older; idiopathic thrombocytopenic purpura in adults and children; and chronic inflammatory demyelinating polyneuropathy in adults.
- Per Grifols, hypersensitivity and anaphylactic/anaphylactoid reactions are a known risk with IVIG products.
- Patients should contact their physician or healthcare provider if they have experienced any problems that may be related to the withdrawn Gamunex-C injection.
- Anyone with an existing inventory of the withdrawn product should stop use and quarantine the product immediately.
