

## Diprolene®/ Diprolene® AF (augmented betamethasone dipropionate) - New warning

- The FDA approved an update to the Warnings and Precautions section of the Diprolene (augmented • betamethasone dipropionate) ointment, Diprolene AF cream and Diprolene lotion drug labels regarding visual disturbance.
- Diprolene is a corticosteroid indicated for the relief of the inflammatory and pruritic manifestations of • corticosteroid-responsive dermatoses in patients  $\geq$  13 years of age.
- Use of topical corticosteroids, including Diprolene and Diprolene AF, may increase the risk of • posterior subcapsular cataracts and glaucoma. Cataracts and glaucoma have been reported postmarketing with the use of topical corticosteroid products, including Diprolene and Diprolene AF.
- Avoid contact of Diprolene and Diprolene AF with eyes. Patients should be advised to report any • visual symptoms and consider referral to an ophthalmologist for evaluation.



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
