

Entereg® (alvimopan) – First-time generic

- On December 1, 2020, <u>Teva launched</u> an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Merck's <u>Entereg (alvimopan)</u> capsules.
- Entereg is approved to accelerate the time to upper and lower gastrointestinal recovery following surgeries that include partial bowel resection with primary anastomosis.
 - Entereg is approved for hospital use only.
- Entereg carries a boxed warning for potential risk of myocardial infarction with long-term use: for short-term hospital use only.



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
