

Buphenyl® (sodium phenylbutyrate) – First-time generic

- On September 19, 2017, Par launched an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Horizon's <u>Buphenyl (sodium phenylbutyrate)</u> 500 mg tablets.
- Buphenyl is indicated as adjunctive therapy in the chronic management of patients with urea cycle
 disorders involving deficiencies of carbamylphosphate synthetase, ornithine transcarbamylase, or
 argininosuccinic acid synthetase.
 - It is indicated in all patients with neonatal-onset deficiency (complete enzymatic deficiency, presenting within the first 28 days of life), and in patients with late-onset disease (partial enzymatic deficiency, presenting after the first month of life) who have a history of hyperammonemic encephalopathy.
- Buphenyl is also available generically as an <u>oral powder</u>.



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
