

Coreg CR® (carvedilol) – First-time generic

- On November 10, 2017, <u>Sun launched AB-rated</u> generic versions of GlaxoSmithKline's <u>Coreg CR</u> (<u>carvedilol</u>) 10 mg, 20 mg, 40 mg, and 80 mg extended-release capsules.
- Coreg CR is indicated for the treatment of mild to severe chronic heart failure, left ventricular dysfunction following myocardial infarction in clinically stable patients, and hypertension.
- Carvedilol is also available generically as 3.125 mg, 6.25 mg, 12.5 mg, and 25 mg tablets.
 - Carvedilol tablets have the same indications as Coreg CR.
 - Carvedilol tablets are administered twice daily. Coreg CR is administered once daily.
- Per IMS, Coreg CR had annual U.S. sales of approximately \$208 million for the 12 months ended August 2017.
