

Estrace® (estradiol) – First-time generic

- On December 29, 2017, <u>Mylan launched</u> an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version and <u>Teva launched</u> an authorized generic of Allergan's <u>Estrace</u> (estradiol) 0.01% vaginal cream.
- Estrace is indicated in the treatment of moderate to severe symptoms of vulvar and vaginal atrophy due to menopause.
- Estrace is also available generically in 0.5 mg, 1 mg, and 2 mg tablets.
 - Estradiol tablets are indicated for the treatment of various indications, including symptoms associated with menopause, hypoestrogenism, breast cancer, prostate cancer, and prevention of osteoporosis.
- Estrace carries a boxed warning for endometrial cancer, cardiovascular disorders, breast cancer and probable dementia.
- According to IQVIA for the 12 months ending October 31, 2017, Estrace vaginal cream had sales of \$449 million.



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
