

Evekeo® (amphetamine) - First-time generic

- On September 30, 2018, Amneal Pharmaceuticals launched an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Arbor Pharmaceuticals' Evekeo (amphetamine) tablets.
 - Amphetamine is a Schedule II controlled substance.
- Evekeo is indicated for the treatment of narcolepsy; attention deficit disorder with hyperactivity (ADHD); and exogenous obesity.
- Amphetamine is also available as the branded products: <u>Adzenys ER™</u> extended-release oral suspension, <u>Adzenys XR-ODT™</u> extended-release orally disintegrating tablets, and <u>Dyanavel® XR</u> extended-release oral suspension.
 - Extended-release amphetamine is only indicated for the treatment of ADHD.
- Evekeo carries a boxed warning for abuse and dependence potential and cardiovascular adverse
 events.



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
