

Invanz® (ertapenem) – First-time generic

- On June 26, 2018, <u>Aurobindo announced</u> the FDA approval of an <u>AP-rated</u> generic version of Merck's <u>Invanz (ertapenem)</u> injection, for the treatment of adult patients and pediatric patients (3 months of age and older) with certain moderate to severe infections caused by susceptible isolates of designated microorganisms; and for the prevention of surgical site infection following elective colorectal surgery.
 - Aurobindo's generic Invanz will launch in July 2018.
- The approved product has an estimated market size of \$387 million for the 12 months ending in April 2018 according to IQVIA.



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
