

Kerydin® (tavaborole) – First-time generic

- On October 15, 2020, Encube Ethicals launched an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Pfizer's <u>Kerydin</u> (tavaborole) 5% topical solution.
 - On October 13, 2020, Perrigo received FDA approval of an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Kerydin. Launch plans are pending.
 - On October 21, 2020, Aleor Dermaceuticals received FDA approval of an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Kerydin. Launch plans are pending.
- Kerydin is approved for the treatment of onychomycosis of the toenails due to *Trichophyton rubrum* or *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*.



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
