

## Makena® (hydroxyprogesterone caproate) – First-time generic

- On June 25, 2018, <u>American Regent launched</u> an <u>AP-rated</u> generic version of AMAG Pharmaceuticals' <u>Makena (hydroxyprogesterone caproate)</u> 250 mg/mL preservative-free injection.
  - Prasco has also launched an authorized generic of Makena.
- Makena is approved to reduce the risk of preterm birth in women with a singleton pregnancy who
  have a history of singleton spontaneous preterm birth. The effectiveness of Makena is based on
  improvement in the proportion of women who delivered < 37 weeks of gestation. There are no
  controlled trials demonstrating a direct clinical benefit, such as improvement in neonatal mortality
  and morbidity.</li>
  - While there are many risk factors for preterm birth, safety and efficacy of Makena has been demonstrated only in women with a prior spontaneous singleton preterm birth. It is not intended for use in women with multiple gestations or other risk factors for preterm birth.
- Makena is also available as a branded 1,250 mg/5 mL with preservative injection and a 275 mg/1.1 mL auto-injector.
  - All Makena products carry the same indication.
