

Sabril® (vigabatrin) – First-time generic

- On January 20, 2019, Teva launched an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Lundbeck's <u>Sabril (vigabatrin)</u> tablets.
- Sabril is approved as adjunctive therapy for adults and pediatric patients 10 years of age and older
 with refractory complex partial seizures who have inadequately responded to several alternative
 treatments and for whom the potential benefits outweigh the risk of vision loss and as monotherapy
 for pediatric patients with infantile spasms 1 month to 2 years of age for whom the potential benefits
 outweigh the potential risk of vision loss.
- Sabril is also available generically as a <u>powder for oral solution</u>. The oral solution formulation shares the same indications as the tablets.
- Sabril carries a boxed warning for permanent vision loss.



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
