

## Tazorac® (tazarotene) – First-time generic

- On April 4, 2017, Taro Pharmaceuticals launched an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Allergan's <u>Tazorac</u> (tazarotene) 0.1% topical cream.
- Tazorac 0.1% topical cream is indicated for the topical treatment of patients with plaque psoriasis and acne vulgaris.
- Brand Tazorac is also available as topical <u>cream</u> (0.05%) and <u>gel</u> (0.05% and 0.1%).
  - The 0.05% cream is indicated for plaque psoriasis but not for acne vulgaris.
  - The 0.05% and 0.1% gels are indicated for the topical treatment of patients with stable plaque psoriasis of up to 20% body surface area involvement.
  - The 0.1% gel is also indicated for the treatment of facial acne vulgaris of mild to moderate severity.
