

## Uloric® (febuxostat) – First-time generic

- On July 1, 2019, <u>Alembic</u> and <u>Mylan</u> launched AB-rated generic versions of Takeda's <u>Uloric</u> (<u>febuxostat</u>) tablets.
  - In addition, Sun Pharmaceuticals received FDA approval of an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Uloric. Launch plans for this generic are pending.
- Uloric is approved for the chronic management of hyperuricemia in adult patients with gout who have an inadequate response to a maximally titrated dose of <u>allopurinol</u>, who are intolerant to allopurinol, or for whom treatment with allopurinol is not advisable.
- Uloric carries a boxed warning for cardiovascular death.
- According to IQVIA<sup>™</sup>, Uloric had estimated U.S. sales of \$578 million for twelve months ending December 2018.



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
