

Zytiga® (abiraterone acetate) – First-time generic

- On November 23, 2018, Patriot Pharmaceuticals launched an authorized generic version of Janssen's <u>Zytiga (abiraterone acetate)</u> 250 mg tablets.
 - Apotex, Hikma, Mylan, and Teva also launched AB-rated generic versions of Zytiga 250 mg tablets.
 - Janssen <u>plans to pursue</u> an injunction against the "at-risk" launch from the various generic manufacturers.
- Zytiga is approved for use in combination with prednisone for the treatment of patients with metastatic castration-resistant prostate cancer (CRPC) or metastatic high-risk castration-sensitive prostate cancer.
- Brand Zytiga is also available as 500 mg tablets. In addition, abiraterone acetate is available as the branded product, Yonsa[®].
 - Yonsa is approved for use in combination with methylprednisolone for the treatment of patients with metastatic CRPC.



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
