Kyzatrex® (testosterone undecanoate) Marius	Testosterone replacement therapy	Testosterone replacement therapy in adult males for conditions associated with a deficiency or absence of endogenous testosterone: Primary hypogonadism (congenital or acquired): testicular failure due to conditions such as cryptorchidism, bilateral torsion, orchitis, vanishing testis syndrome, orchiectomy, Klinefelter syndrome, chemotherapy, or toxic damage from alcohol or heavy metals. These men usually have low serum testosterone concentrations and gonadotropins (follicle-stimulating hormone, luteinizing hormone) above the normal range; Hypogonadotropic hypogonadism (congenital or acquired): gonadotropin or luteinizing hormone-releasing hormone deficiency, pituitary-hypothalamic injury from tumors, trauma, or radiation. These men have low serum testosterone concentrations but have gonadotropins in the normal or low range.	TBD

Zonisade ™ (zonisamide) Azurity	Anticonvulsant	Adjunctive therapy for the treatment of partial-onset seizures in adults and pediatric patients 16 years and older	TBD
Zoryve [™] (roflumilast) Arcutis Biotherapeutics	Phosphodiesterase-4 inhibitor	Topical treatment of plaque psoriasis, including intertriginous areas, in patients 12 years of age and older	August 2, 2022
