

Pfizer/BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine - CDC recommends boosters in 16 - 17-year-olds

- On December 9, 2021, the <u>CDC Director recommended</u> the use of the <u>Pfizer/BioNTech COVID-19</u> <u>vaccine</u>, for a single booster dose to individuals 16 years of age and older who have completed a primary series with Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine or Comirnaty[®]. This expands the use of Comirnaty as a booster which was previously indicated only for adults 18 years and older.
 - This recommendation follows closely after the <u>FDA announced</u> an expanded emergency use authorization (EUA) for a booster dose for individuals 16-17 years of age on December 9, 2021.
- The CDC director also stated that initial data suggests that COVID-19 boosters help broaden and strengthen the protection against Omicron and other variants.
