

## Plastikon Healthcare – Recall of Milk of Magnesia, acetaminophen, and magnesium hydroxide/aluminum hydroxide/simethicone products

- On March 24, 2022, [Plastikon Healthcare announced](#) a voluntarily consumer-level recall of some lots of [Milk of Magnesia](#), [acetaminophen](#), and [magnesium hydroxide/aluminum hydroxide/simethicone](#) single dose cups due to the microbial contamination and failure to properly investigate failed microbial testing.
- The following products were distributed nationwide between May 2020 and June 2021.

- Milk of Magnesia is indicated for the occasional relief of constipation in adults and children 12 years and older or for children under 12 as recommended by a doctor.
- Magnesium hydroxide/aluminum hydroxide/simethicone is indicated for relief of acid indigestion, heartburn, sour stomach, upset stomach due to these symptoms, pressure and bloating commonly referred to as gas.
- Acetaminophen is indicated for temporarily relief of minor aches and pains due to, minor pain of arthritis, muscular aches, backache, premenstrual and menstrual cramps, the common cold, headache, toothache, and temporarily reduction of fever.
- These products potentially could result in illness due to intestinal distress, such as diarrhea or abdominal pain. Individuals with a compromised immune system have a higher probability of developing a wide-spread, potentially life-threatening infection when ingesting or otherwise orally exposed to products contaminated by micro-organisms.
- To date, Plastikon has not received any reports of adverse events related to this recall.
- Anyone with an existing inventory of the recalled product should stop use, distribution and quarantine the product immediately.
- Patients should contact their physician or health care provider if they have experienced any problems that may be related to taking or using Plastikon Healthcare’s recalled products.
