



Methyldopa – Long-term drug shortage

- The [drug shortage](#) of [methyldopa](#) tablets is ongoing. Methyldopa tablets have been unavailable for at least 90 days.
 - Accord has temporarily discontinued methyldopa tablets and there is no information as to when or if the product will be available at a future date.
 - [Mylan discontinued](#) methyldopa tablets on October 8, 2021.
- Methyldopa is indicated for the treatment of hypertension.
