

Various manufacturers – Supply of generic Tamiflu® (oseltamivir)

- The supply of generic <u>Tamiflu (oseltamivir)</u>, used to treat influenza, is being monitored by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP), who are working closely to share drug supply information.
- Although oseltamivir has experienced some <u>supply disruptions</u>, <u>product is available</u> from both brand and generic manufacturers. However, there may be periodic local outages of product in retail. Supply of other antiviral medications, including <u>Relenza®</u> (<u>zanamivir</u>) and <u>Xofluza®</u> (<u>baloxavir marboxil</u>) are available. Some manufacturers report that more supply of oseltamivir will be available late-December 2022.
- The <u>CDC reports</u> that seasonal influenza activity is elevated across the U.S, which is likely contributing to the supply disruption.
