

Divigel® (estradiol) – First-time generic

- On September 27, 2022, Xiromed launched Chemo's <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Vertical's Divigel (estradiol) transdermal gel.
 - Xiromed/Chemo received 180-days of Competitive Generic Therapy exclusivity.
- Divigel is approved for the treatment of moderate to severe vasomotor symptoms due to menopause.
- Estradiol is also available generically as <u>vaginal cream</u>, <u>transdermal system</u>, <u>vaginal insert</u>, and an <u>oral tablet</u>.
 - Estradiol vaginal cream is indicated for the treatment of moderate to severe symptoms of vulvar and vaginal atrophy due to menopause.
 - Estradiol transdermal system is indicated for the treatment of moderate to severe vasomotor symptoms due to menopause and for the prevention of postmenopausal osteoporosis.
 - Estradiol vaginal insert is indicated for the treatment of atrophic vaginitis due to menopause.
 - Estradiol oral tablet is indicated for same indications as the topical forms and carries additional indications.
- Divigel carries a boxed warning for endometrial cancer, cardiovascular disorders, probable dementia and breast cancer.



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
