

## Liptruzet<sup>®</sup> (atorvastatin/ezetimibe) – First-time generic

- On January 4, 2023, <u>Althera launched</u> a <u>generic version</u> of Merck's discontinued Liptruzet (atorvastatin/ezetimibe) tablets.
  - Merck notified the FDA on June 1, 2015, that Liptruzet tablets were being discontinued. The <u>FDA determined</u> that Liptruzet tablets were not withdrawn for reasons of safety or effectiveness.
- <u>Atorvastatin/ezetimibe</u> is approved for primary hyperlipidemia and homozygous familial hypercholesterolemia.



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
