

Naftin® (naftifine) - First-time generic

- On April 12, 2023, Taro launched an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Sebela's <u>Naftin (naftifine)</u> 2% topical gel.
- Naftin is approved for the treatment of interdigital tinea pedis caused by the organisms *Trichophyton rubrum*, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*, and *Epidermophyton floccosum*.
- Naftifine is also available generically as a <u>1% gel</u>, <u>1% cream</u> and <u>2% cream</u>.
 - Naftifine 1% gel is approved for the topical treatment of tinea pedis, tinea cruris and tinea corporis caused by the organisms *Trichophyton rubrum*, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*, *Trichophyton tonsurans* and *Epidermophyton floccosum*.
 - Naftifine 1% cream is approved for the treatment of tinea pedis, tinea cruris and tinea corporis caused by the organisms *Trichophyton rubrum*, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*, and *Epidermophyton floccosum*.
 - Naftifine 2% cream is approved for the treatment of interdigital tinea pedis, tinea cruris, and tinea corporis caused by the organism *Trichophyton rubrum*.



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
