



New OptumRx Home Delivery Pharmacy Opioid Dispensing Limits

As the newest component of our ongoing efforts to combat the opioid epidemic, OptumRx Home Delivery Pharmacy is introducing a bold new operational standard within the home delivery market.

Starting **July 1, 2018**, OptumRx Home Delivery Pharmacy will limit dispensing of opioid prescriptions to a 30-day supply at one time for commercial members

- Members who currently receive more than a 30-day supply at home delivery will need a new prescription or authorized refill as appropriate from their prescriber.
- In most states, prescribers can send an electronic prescription to the pharmacy to help ensure quick and continued access for members in need of chronic opioid therapy – with no disruption.

Led by leaders and clinical experts across the organization, our approach is being rolled out in phases and you will hear more about dispensing changes for non-commercial members in the coming months.

OptumRx introduced a multi-dimensional Opioid Risk Management solution last year. We continue to advance our solution suite to not only stop abuse before it starts, but also prevent progression to misuse and addiction – and support individuals in their recovery.
