



Lumigan® (bimatoprost) — First-Time Generic

- On February 23, 2015, [Lupin announced](#) the FDA approval of its [AT-rated](#) generic to Allergan's [Lumigan \(bimatoprost\)](#) 0.03% ophthalmic solution, for the reduction of elevated intraocular pressure in patients with open angle glaucoma or ocular hypertension.
 - Brand Lumigan 0.03% is no longer commercially available.
 - Brand Lumigan is available as a [0.01% ophthalmic solution](#) and has the same indication as the 0.03% ophthalmic solution. Generics are not available for the 0.01% strength.
- Bimatoprost is also available as a 0.03% ophthalmic solution ([Latisse®](#)) to treat hypotrichosis of the eyelashes by increasing their growth including length, thickness and darkness.
- Lupin plans to launch generic Lumigan 0.03% ophthalmic solution soon.



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
