



Ortho Tri-Cyclen[®] Lo (norgestimate/ethinyl estradiol) – First-time Generic

- On December 31, 2015, Actavis, Sandoz, Mylan, and Teva launched first-time generic versions of Janssen's Ortho Tri-Cyclen Lo (norgestimate/ethinyl estradiol).
 - Actavis' generic is an authorized generic of Ortho Tri-Cyclen Lo.
 - Generics by Teva and Sandoz are AB-rated to Ortho Tri-Cyclen Lo.
 - There will be no market exclusivity.
- Ortho Tri-Cyclen Lo is approved for use by females of reproductive potential to prevent pregnancy.
- Generic Ortho Tri-Cyclen Lo will be available in a blister card with a dispenser containing seven tablets of each of the following strengths (norgestimate/ethinyl estradiol): 0.18 mg/0.025 mg, 0.215 mg/0.025 mg, 0.25 mg/0.025 mg, and non-hormonal placebo.
- Ortho Tri-Cyclen Lo carries a boxed warning for cigarette smoking and serious cardiovascular events.



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
